

EMPH Application Submission Checklist

Application Review

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis from October through July.
Applications are batched and begin the review process on the following dates:

Priority Review: February 1

Subsequent Reviews: March 1, April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1



To apply to the UCLA Fielding School of Public Health EMPH Program, applicants must complete the following application procedures:

- Submit a UCLA Graduate Division online application at <https://apply.grad.ucla.edu/apply/>
(please note applicants applying to the EMPH Program do NOT need to submit/complete a SOPHAS application)
 - **'Plans for Graduate Study'**
 - **Major** = 'Executive Master of Public Health MPH Weekend Program'
 - **Apply Term** = 'Fall'

- Submit a Statement of Purpose in the online application under the **'Statement of Purpose'** section.
- Submit a Personal Statement in the online application under the **'Personal Statement'** section.
- Submit a Professional Resume in the online application under the **'Supporting Documents'** section.
- Submit **three** Letters of Recommendation – Input recommender's name and email and the system will email them directly. If you already have your letters of recommendation, you may email them to emph@ucla.edu.
- GRE/GMAT scores: Test scores can be waived if you have at least 5 years of work experience and an undergraduate GPA above a 3.0 or if you have a terminal degree and are licensed in the state of California. To submit test scores as part of the review, upload under the **'Test Scores'** section and use school code 4837.
- Submit TOEFL scores in the **'Test Scores'** section of the online application (*for international applicants only*).
