Application Review

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis from September through July. Review Dates: February 1, March 1, April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1

Admissions Requirements:

To be considered for admission to the EMPH program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution
- Cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 (contact program office to discuss your eligibility if you do not meet this requirement)
- Three years of professional work experience in any industry

Application Materials:

EMPH applicants do NOT need to complete a SOPHAS application and GRE is NOT required

0	Focus on your professional goals and reasons for pursuing an EMPH. Describe any experience from your career in contributing to the fields of healthcare or public health. Discuss your objectives after you receive your EMPH.	
Personal statement		
0	Upload to the online application	
0	Discuss the personal experiences that brought you to apply for an EMPH, focusing on any challenges or barriers that have influenced your decision.	
Professional Résumé		
0	Upload to the online application	
0	Résumé should show a minimum of three years of professional experience.	
Three letters of recommendation		
0	Upload to the online application	
0	Letters may be from professional or academic sources on letterhead	
TOEFL	or IELTS scores (international applicants only)	
0	Self-reported scores can be submitted to the online application	
0	Have testing service send official scores directly to UCLA (ETS School code: 4837)
